Anne McLean has been involved with the Environmental Jobs Network on a volunteer basis since 2002 and has been an Executive Board member since 2004.

Her career has taken her from working in Local Government in Melbourne to achieving her dream job as Sustainable Transport Officer at Hobsons Bay City Council where she successfully implemented several programs and received two grants totalling \$340,000 from the Victorian Government.

Anne currently works at Victoria University as a Sustainability Officer allowing her to branch out beyond transport into other areas of sustainability.

Gordana Marin is the Manager, Strategy and Development with the Office of the Commissioner for Environmental Sustainability. Prior to this she was in a managerial role with the Department of Sustainability and Environment Victoria. Gordana has a social sciences background with a particular interest in climate change and sustainability. At DSE Gordana managed the establishment of the Victorian Ministerial Council on Climate Change Adaptation and convened the Working Group for Victoria's Inter Departmental Committee on Climate Change Adaptation.

Prior to joining DSE, Gordana worked in a number of policy areas including the development of the Victorian Government's Renewable Energy Target Scheme, the establishment of Financial Hardship Policies for energy consumers and the development of the Victorian Government's Elder Abuse Prevention policy framework.
