Perspectives on the 2009 influenza pandemic in Victoria

Heath will present a perspective on the pandemic that uses evidence from state, national and international surveillance to place the pandemic in context. In this context he will challenge some of the interventions used and will draw attention to gaps in our understanding of influenza epidemiology.

Heath Kelly is Head of Epidemiology at the Victorian Infectious Diseases Reference Laboratory and an honorary Associate Professor in the Melbourne School of Population Health. He has been involved in influenza surveillance for more than a decade and, reflected by a number of online publications, has had a keen interest in understanding the influenza pandemic of 2009 as it has unfolded.
